

Calmar City Council March 4, 2019

Mayor Keith Frana called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. at the Calmar Fire Station. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were: Schissel, Sabelka, Kirkeberg, and Kleve. Ondrashek was absent.

Mayor Frana announced that there would be a new format for Comments and Questions from the public. Each person wanting to speak will sign a sheet and get 3 minutes to talk.
