

Minutes Calmar City Council
March 10, 2021

Mayor Frana called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. on March 10, 2021 at the Calmar City Hall. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were: Kleve, Kirkeberg, Schissel, Sabelka and Gerlich. Also present: Keith Frana, Matt Bullerman, Junior Boyer, Don Wurtzel, Sheila Bullerman, Jared Bucksa and Joe Ward showed up a little later.

Junior Boyer and Matt Bullerman addressed the council with more information regarding the pay loaders discussed at the last council meeting (attachments, loan, rate, bonding attorney).

Motion by Kleve, second by Schissel to approve Resolution #633 approving setting the date for a public hearing on proposal to enter into a General Obligation Equipment Acquisition Loan Agreement and to borrow money thereunder in a principal amount not to exceed \$175,000. Aye: Kleve, Schissel, Kirkeberg, Sabelka and Gerlich. Motion carried.

Mayor Keith Frana addressed the council with the future resurfacing of 175th Street. Junior Boyer said he talked to Jeff Kuboushek who was going to talk with Lee Bjerke. T.J. Schissel is going to set up a meeting with the Winneshiek County Engineer and the City of Calmar representatives regarding this project.

Don Wurtzel has been working on the USDA grant for our next police vehicle. Joe Ward was present with some information that he has collected (thinking about going with a truck for the best resale value down the road). Joe will get quotes and more information for the council.

Motion by Kleve, second by Sabelka to adjourn. Aye: Kleve, Sabelka, Schissel, Kirkeberg and Gerlich. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
